The annual meeting of the LLCA was held on Wednesday, January 16, 2019. Five homeowners were elected unanimously to serve on the board. Elected board members are: **Mark Snyder**, President, **Doug Rankin**, Vice-President, **Cassie Yost**, Secretary, **Julie Zhou**, Treasurer and **Kyra Frederick**, Member at Large. Cassie Yost is the newest board member, and is taking the place of Angie Schell, who decided to step down this year. The neighborhood owes a large debt of gratitude for all the hard work Angie has done for the community over her many years of service. Mark Snyder discussed the 2019 budget and the slight increase in annual dues because of the change in the government's taxing of services and utilities. Speeding as a neighborhood concern was brought up. While the speed hump initiative didn't garner the necessary votes needed to move forward last year, it was discussed in the meeting to look into again the possibility of hiring an off-duty policeman to patrol the neighborhood and maybe install monitoring equipment for speeders.
