

## LANDIS LAKES COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION BOARD MEETING WITH THE RESIDENTS

There will be a Landis Lakes Community Association Board Meeting on Tuesday, September 18 at 7:00 PM at the clubhouse. All residents are encouraged to attend this meeting.



The Board will be discussing and voting on the following amendments:

1. We will be voting to increase the number of board members from three to five.
2. We will introduce a measure to levy fines against residents who are found to be in violation of community restrictions (to "add teeth" per se, to restrictions, as currently there is nothing that can be done to enforce restrictions).

Residents will be able to discuss the amendments before the board votes on the amendments.

Incidentally, the recent amendment that gives the board the ability to alter the current by-laws, with a super majority of the board, was approved by the community with the required 67% of the residents voting.
